### To Line or Not to Line.....

*That is the question!*

Lining adds stability to a drapery or top treatment protecting it from the sun's harmful rays. Lining also gives extra body to those lighter weight fabrics.

Line?....YES!!

### Fullness??

Drapery fullness is not the same for every style. Fullness typically ranges from 2-3 times the desired width. Some styles such as a traditional pinch pleat require more fullness to accommodate for pleating. Allow us to help you determine what fullness works best for the style you have selected.

### Supply List:

- Tape Measure
- Screwdriver
- Pencil
- Drill
- Level
- Wall Anchors
- Hardware

When installing draperies and window treatments consider these points.

- Furniture placement
- Artwork position near windows
- Wall space limitations for stacking off the window
- Proper projection to clear blinds, shades & shutters
- The length of your drape is not the height at which you mount the hardware.
- You do not have to mount the hardware on the window casing. Try mounting higher to add height to the room and wider to optimize the light source.

### The Finishing Touch

*Without the right hardware, your window treatment will not be Complete. Like leaving home without your shoes, that finishing touch can make or break the look you desire. When you have gone to the extra expense of custom treatments why cheap out now? The wrong hardware can ruin a style.*

Consider This:

- Height of the room
- Weight of the treatments
- Width hardware must cover
- Function of hardware
- Finish
- Size of Finials
